Instructions:

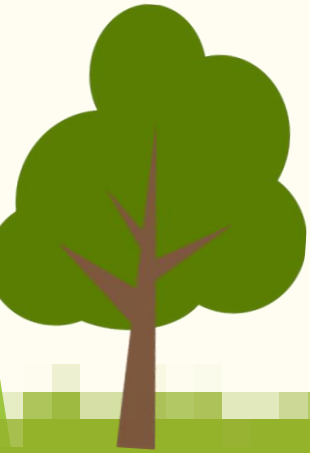
1. Each student from Class I & II is required to bring a flowering plant such as:

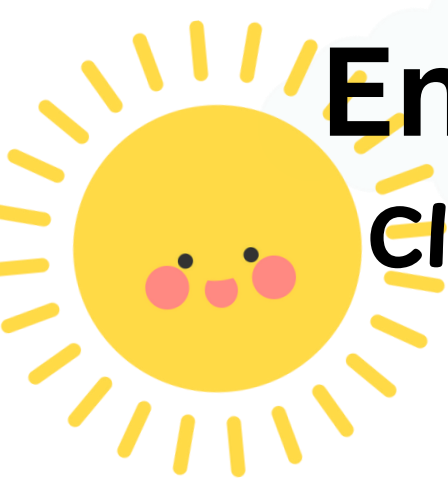
- Gulab (Rose)

2. Plants should be brought in a properly sized pot suitable for the plant's growth.

Ensure:

- Good drainage (hole at the bottom of the pot)
- Stable and manageable size (not too small or too large)
- Label the pot with student's name and class

Posters/Portrait Making, Slogan Writing Activity

Rules:

1. Poster/Portrait:

- Paper size: A3 or chart paper (1/4th size) only
- Use of eco-friendly materials encouraged

- Include name, class, and roll number on the back

2. Slogan Writing:

- Length: Maximum 12 words
- Must be original and related to the environment
- Neatly written or illustrated in a creative style

- Students must bring their own materials and manage their quick changes if needed.

- Use of expressions, body language, voice modulation, and dialogue delivery is essential.
- Avoid long dialogues or reading from paper.

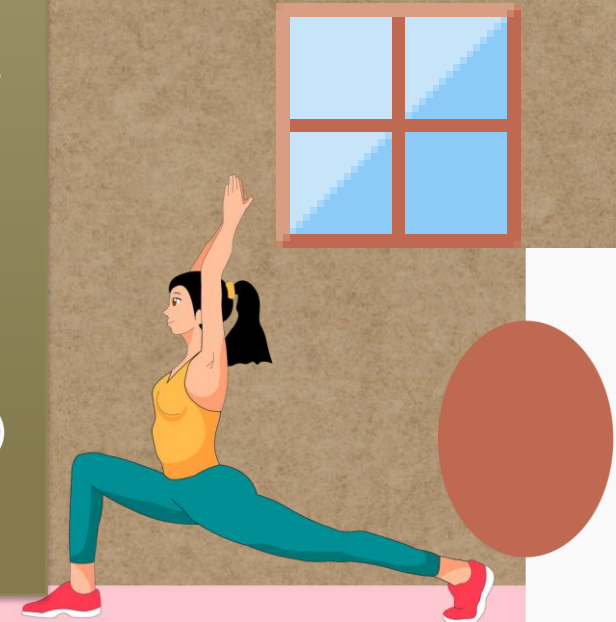
1. Tadasana (Palm tree pose)

5. 5. Shirshasana (Headstand)

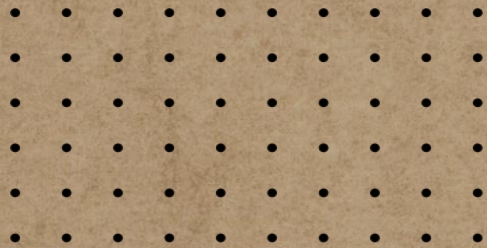


FINAL ROUND YOGA COMPETITION

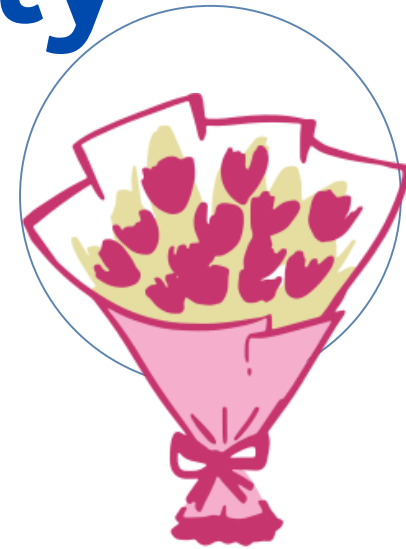
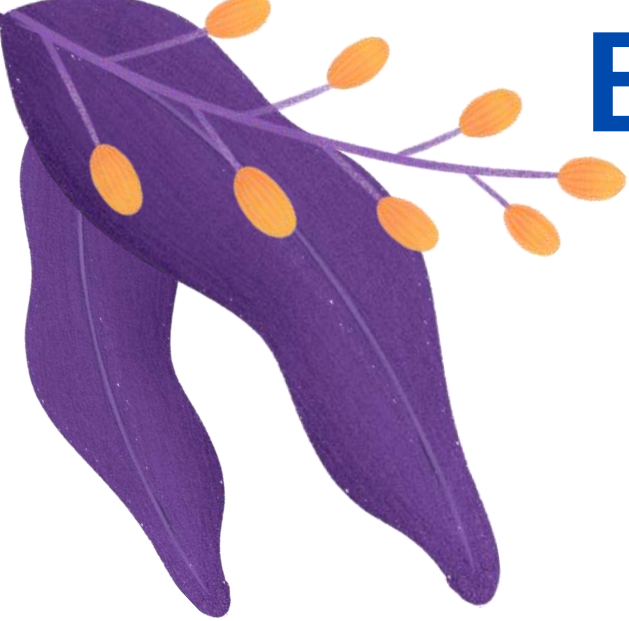
Bouquet Making Activity
